His extensive coaching experience has covered all levels of soccer in the United States from youth, high school, collegiate, and professional, including stop as: former Boy's Director of Coaching for CPUSA, Asst. Coach Pittsburgh Riverhounds (USL 1st Division), Head Coach Univ. of Central Arkansas (NCAA DII Final Four), Director of Coaching Indiana Youth Soccer Association, and Asst. Coach West Texas A&M Univ. He also served as an ODP staff coach in Arkansas, Texas, Illinois, and Region III. Lion Camp

Lion Camp is designed to develop the basic techniques/skills of soccer: dribbling, ball control, heading, passing & shooting by teaching in a progressive manner (from simple to complex) and allow the players to practice these skills, while exposing them to tactical decision making through small-sided play, such as 2v2, 3v3 and 4v4.

The activities and small-sided games will create an environment that will develop creativity and problem solving skills, allow for individual differences, and develop exciting players.

Cub & Lion Camp Info

TUITION INCLUDES: Camp T-shirt, instruction, swimming and before & after care.

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES: Campers will arrive & depart each day from the SLU soccer fields located next to the Marion Bowman Center.

Senior Elite Residential Camp

Team Camp

Boys - July 16-19 Ages 9-18 Tuition \$399.00 (per player)

The team camp is an excellent opportunity for a team and the coach to train, compete and live in a demanding soccer environment. The camp curriculum will feature small group and team tactical training sessions. The curriculum will also feature functional training that is specific to the various positions and relative to the various thirds of the field. Teams will be able to incorporate what they have learned into competitive evening matches. Team coaches will attend the camp free of charge with their team and are asked to help serve in a supervisory capacity and be actively involved in training. Staff coaches and team coaches will meet daily to discuss the upcoming training sessions.

Residential Goalkeeper Camp

Goalkeepers will train separately twice a day and join the field players for the last part of the morning and afternoon session for shooting and crossing and finishing. They will also take part in the evening matches. A total instructional program is covered including: positioning, catching, footwork, distribution, diving, one on one, and the psychology of goalkeeping.

Location

Saint Leo University is conveniently located 30 miles north of downtown Tampa. Take I-75 to exit# 285 (SR 52). Head east on HWY 52 for about 4.5 miles. Saint Leo University will be on the left, across the street from the Abbey Golf Course.

Residential, Team, & Goalkeeper Camp Features

The Saint Leo Soccer Camp will feature a College Recruiting Forum & Peer Talks providing campers the opportunity to interact with college coaches and players about "what it takes" to be a college athlete. Sessions and demonstration will be held regarding speed, strength and conditioning for the elite soccer player.

Commuters

Participants wishing to commute may do so for a \$335.00 tuition fee, which includes five meals (dinner Saturday, lunch & dinner on Sunday & Monday. A commuters day will begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at approximately 9:30 p.m. allowing him to participate in all the days activities.

Supervision

Adult staff members will live in the residence halls with the campers, providing 24-hour supervision. In addition, SLU provides residence hall and campus security.

Tuition

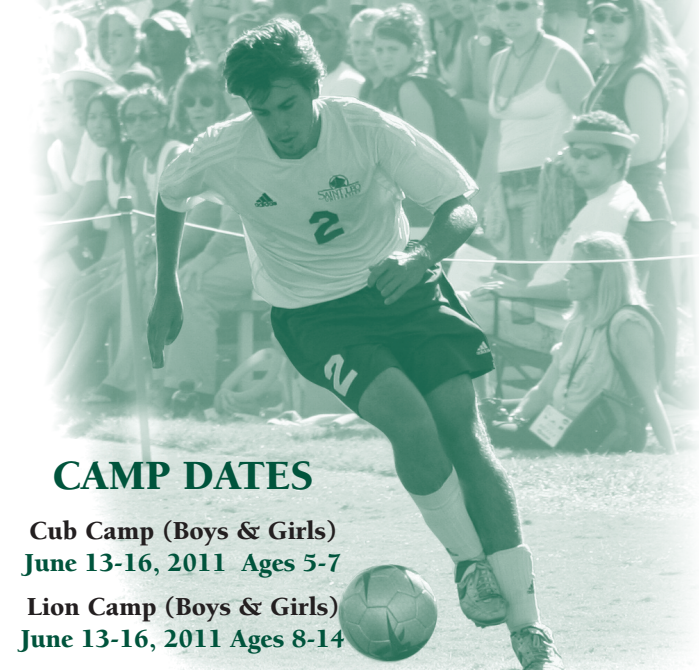
